Thank you for considering the importance of the next Annual Meeting and supporting the club by attending.

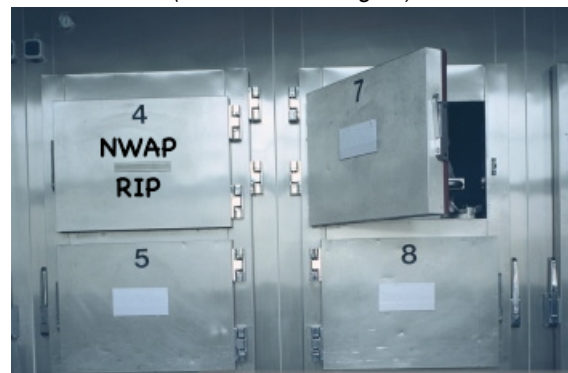
